### **HISTORY**

**February, 2009**—Publication of the “Legislative Commission to End Poverty in Minnesota by 2020” (LCEP) Legislative Report. <sup>(1)</sup>

**February, 2010**—Several hundred people state-wide (100 in Rochester) celebrated the publication anniversary with an evening of conversation, education and advocacy.

**May, 2010**—Legislature passes the significant “Ladder Out of Poverty” task force bill. <sup>(2)</sup> An AMNWOP-initiated <sup>(3)</sup> micro-loan process is directly related to three of the LCEP recommendations: “Making Work Pay, Building Financial Assets, and Strengthening Community Infrastructure.”
